**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO DISBURSE  
SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS  
IN THE CLIENT LETTER IDENTIFIED AS EXHIBIT 1**

The Court has reviewed *Plaintiffs' Motion Demonstrating Compliance with Paragraphs 6-7 of the Resolution Judges' Mediation Order* (Transaction ID 58937774), including the April 1, 2016, client letter identified as Exhibit 1 to the motion, and the signatures of Plaintiffs identified as Exhibit 2 to the motion. Having conferred with one another to insure uniformity of their decision, as contemplated by West Virginia Trial Court Rule 26.07(a), the Presiding Judges **FIND** that Plaintiffs' counsel is in compliance with Paragraphs 6-7 of the *Order Governing Mediation and Mediation Statements* (Transaction ID 58152601), which require Plaintiffs' informed consent to any settlement reached, and detailed disclosures before obtaining each client's consent to settle where an aggregate settlement is reached.

The Presiding Judges **ORDER** Plaintiffs' counsel to disburse the settlement proceeds in accordance with the terms specified in the April 1, 2016, client letter identified as Exhibit 1 to Plaintiffs' motion, upon receipt of the settlement proceeds from Defendants and their insurance carriers. After all releases have been executed and all settlement proceeds have been distributed, the parties are **ORDERED** to submit a proposed agreed order dismissing the LPG Land Litigation in its entirety, with prejudice.
