

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

SUPREME COURT OF APPEALS OF WEST VIRGINIA

RE: APPOINTMENTS TO THE MASS LITIGATION PANEL


Pursuant to Rule 26.02 of the West Virginia Trial Court Rules, the Chief Justice, with the approval of the full Court, shall appoint seven (7) active or senior status circuit court judges to serve on the Mass Litigation Panel for a term of three (3) years, with two (2) judges to be appointed each year; provided, however, that beginning in 2009, and in every third year thereafter, three (3) judges shall be appointed. Pursuant to Rule 26.02, the Chief Justice shall also annually designate a Panel member to serve as its Chair. The three-year terms of the Honorable Alan D. Moats, Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, and the Honorable John A. Hutchison, Judge of the Tenth Judicial Circuit, will expire on June 30, 2014.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, that the Honorable Alan D. Moats, Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, and the Honorable John A. Hutchison, Judge of the Tenth Judicial Circuit, be reappointed to serve on the Mass Litigation Panel from July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2017, and that Judge Moats be reappointed to serve as the Chair of the Mass Litigation Panel from July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ACKNOWLEDGED, that the Panel members and the expiration dates of their terms shall now be as follows:
