ORDER APPOINTING DISCOVERY COMMISSIONER

Having reviewed the “Notice of Plaintiffs’ and Defendants’ Joint Submission of Proposed Discovery Commissioners” (TID 56536247) the Court appoints Webster J. Arceneaux, III to serve as Discovery Commissioner in the Carbon Monoxide Exposure Litigation.

No later than March 16, 2015, Liaison Counsel shall provide the Discovery Commissioner with a combined list of all discovery motions to be resolved prior to the April 3, 2015, Pretrial Hearing, along with a copy of each such motion, response and reply. The list of discovery motions shall be filed in the Master Case File and served on all counsel of record, the Presiding Judges and the Mass Litigation Manager **no later than March 16, 2015**, and shall include the title and Transaction Identification Number of each such discovery motion, response and reply.

A hearing on the discovery motions will be conducted on a date, and at a time and location to be determined by the Discovery Commissioner. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Discovery Commissioner shall provide the Court with a report of his recommendations as to each motion heard, along with his time expended, fees incurred, and recommendation as to how the fees should be split among the parties.
