ORDER

On April 3, 2015, came the parties by their respective counsel, for a Pretrial Conference in the Carbon Monoxide Exposure litigation. Whereupon, Plaintiffs' counsel Scott S. Segal and Marvin W. Masters announced to the Court that all of their cases were fully compromised and settled.

Thereafter, Plaintiffs' counsel advised the Court there are remaining issues regarding aggregate settlements between Plaintiffs and Defendants Premier Pools, LLC, Steve Combs, Karen Combs, J.P. Mechanical, Inc. and John Providenti, which Plaintiffs believe should be resolved by the Resolution Judges. The Court **ORDERS** that any issues regarding the aforementioned aggregate settlements should go back to the Resolution Judges. Plaintiffs' Counsel Scott S. Segal and Marvin W. Masters are directed to file and serve a proposed order pursuant to Trial Court Rule 24.01 setting forth all such issues the Resolution Judges need to resolve.

The Pretrial Conference in this matter was scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. on April 3, 2015. However, Plaintiffs' counsel Gordon C. Lane did not appear at the Pretrial Conference until sometime after 10:00 a.m. Finding Plaintiffs' counsel Gordon C. Lane's delay to be in contempt of Court, the Court *sua sponte* fined Mr. Lane the sum of \$100. Accordingly, Plaintiffs' counsel Gordon C. Lane is **ORDERED**, within 15 days of the entry of this Order, to pay the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Kanawha County, West Virginia, the sum of \$100.

During the course of the Pretrial Conference, the Court stood in recess and, thereafter,

Plaintiffs' counsel Gordon C. Lane announced to the Court that all of his cases were fully compromised and settled. There being no further issues pending before the Court, the Pretrial Conference was adjourned.

The Court directs Defendants' Liaison Counsel Brian Warner to, within 15 days of the entry of this Order, file and serve a proposed order pursuant to Trial Court Rule 24.01 memorializing the settlements achieved at the Pretrial Conference on April 3, 2015.

It is so **ORDERED**.
