ORDER RESCHEDULING HEARING

The December 22, 2014 hearing on various motions in the Carbon Monoxide Litigation is **ORDERED RESCHEDULED to 10:00 a.m. on December 18, 2014.** The hearing will be conducted in Courtroom Four, also known as **the Ceremonial Courtroom**, on the Second Floor of the Kanawha County Courthouse, at 409 Virginia Street, East, in **Charleston, West Virginia.**

The Court will hear the following motions:

1. *Motion to Enjoin Settlement Payment to Any Plaintiff Until an Aggregate Settlement is Reached* (Transaction ID 56266323);
2. *Plaintiffs' Combined Motion for (1) an Emergency Hearing on the Dissolution of the Temporary Restraining Order Granted on October 31, 2014; and (2) Motion for Bond Regarding the Same* (Transaction ID 56288375);
3. All dispositive motions regarding the Complaint for Declaratory Relief filed by Nautilus Insurance Company;
4. Defendants' Joint Motion to Stay Discovery Regarding Damages (Transaction ID 56181879); and
5. Any unresolved discovery motions.

Liaison Counsel shall confer with their respective co-counsel and with one another, and **by no later than December 12, 2014**, jointly file in the Master Case File and serve on all counsel a list of discovery motions that remain unresolved, including the filing dates and Transaction Identification Numbers of the motions, as well as any responses and replies to the

motions.

The schedule for briefing of dispositive motions regarding the Complaint for Declaratory Relief by Nautilus Insurance Company remains as follows:

1. All dispositive motions regarding the Complaint for Declaratory Relief filed by Nautilus Insurance Company shall be filed by **December 5, 2014**.
2. All responses to dispositive motions regarding the Complaint for Declaratory Relief filed by Nautilus Insurance Company shall be filed by **December 16, 2014**.
