

**FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND
RECOMMENDATION OF THE MASS LITIGATION PANEL**

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2014, "Plaintiff's Expedited Motion to Refer Cases to the Mass Litigation Panel" ("Motion to Refer") was filed in the *Andrews* civil action (13-C-434-3) pending in the Circuit Court of Harrison County, West Virginia. On June 16, 2014, Defendants Antero Resources Corporation, Antero Resources Bluestone LLC (collectively "Antero") and Hall Drilling, LLC ("Hall") filed their respective Responses in Opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion to Refer.

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2014, Plaintiffs' Expedited Motion to Refer was filed in the *Shreves* civil action (14-C-20) pending in the Circuit Court of Ritchie County, West Virginia. On June 30, 2014, Defendants Antero and Hall filed their respective Responses in Opposition to Plaintiffs' Expedited Motion to Refer in the *Shreves* civil action.

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2014, Plaintiffs' Expedited Motion to Refer was filed in the *Stutler* civil action (14-C-242-3) pending in the Circuit Court of Harrison County, West Virginia. On June 23, 2014, and July 16, 2014, respectively, Defendants Antero and Hall filed their Responses in Opposition to Plaintiffs' Expedited Motion to Refer in the *Stutler* civil action.

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2014, the Honorable Timothy L. Sweeney ordered the Circuit Clerk to transmit to the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Appeals for filing a copy of Plaintiffs' Expedited Motion to Refer in the *Shreves* civil action.

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2014, the Honorable James A. Matish filed the "Circuit Court's Reply Memorandum in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion to Refer Cases to Mass Litigation Panel" in the *Andrews* civil action.

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2014, the Honorable Thomas A. Bedell ordered Civil Action Nos. 14-C-280-2, 14-C-281-2, 14-C-282-2 and 14-C-286-2 consolidated, and on August 11, 2014, filed the "Circuit Court's Reply Memorandum in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion to Refer Cases to Mass Litigation Panel and Recommending Referral of These Consolidated Actions."

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2014, Plaintiffs filed their "Supplemental Brief in Support of Plaintiffs' Expedited Motion to Refer Cases to Mass Litigation Panel" in the *Shreves* pending civil action.

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2014, the Honorable James A. Matish filed "Circuit Court's Reply Memorandum in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion to Refer Cases to Mass Litigation Panel" in

the *Stutler* civil action, together with an “Order Directing Circuit Clerk to Transmit Amended Motion to Refer to the Mass Litigation Panel and All Reply Memoranda to Clerk of the Supreme Court of Appeals.”

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2014, pursuant to Rule 26.06(c)(2) of the West Virginia Trial Court Rules, Chief Justice Davis ordered the Mass Litigation Panel or a designated member thereof to conduct a hearing to receive evidence and entertain arguments by the parties or any judge relative to the issue of whether these cases should be referred to the Mass Litigation Panel, and to submit findings of fact and a recommendation to the Chief Justice, including a specific list of the cases affected by the recommendation.

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2014, The Honorable Alan D. Moats, Chair, Mass Litigation Panel ordered that a hearing be conducted on September 9, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. for the purpose of receiving evidence and entertaining arguments by the parties or any judge relative to the issue of whether these cases should be referred to the Mass Litigation Panel, and to submit findings of fact and a recommendation to the Chief Justice, including a specific list of the cases affected by the recommendation.

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2014, Plaintiffs filed “Plaintiffs’ Supplemental List of Cases for Consideration by the Mass Litigation Panel” identifying 17 current Marcellus Shale cases with 59 claimants pending in various West Virginia circuit courts (Exhibit A), along with approximately 49 cases with approximately 98 claimants awaiting to be filed (Exhibit B), all based on the same operative facts and against the same defendants as were named in *Andrews*, *Stutler* and *Shreves*.

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2014, the Mass Litigation Panel, upon proper notice, convened and received evidence and arguments by counsel for the plaintiffs, counsel for Antero

Resources Corporation, and counsel for Hall Drilling, LLC relative to the issue of whether these cases should be referred to the Mass Litigation Panel.

NOW THEREFORE, having considered all of the submissions of the parties and the Harrison County Circuit Court in support of the Motions to Refer, and having heard argument of counsel in support of and in opposition to the Motions to Refer, the Panel makes the following **FINDINGS** and **RECOMMENDATION** to the Chief Justice:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The civil actions that comprise this potential Mass Litigation all arise out of nuisance claims relating to drilling activities conducted by the Defendants in three separate counties (Harrison, Ritchie and Doddridge) in West Virginia.

2. There are 17 current Marcellus Shale cases pending with 59 claimants in 7 different circuit courts before 8 different judges. See Exhibit A.

3. The actions are pending in the following 7 counties: Doddridge (5 actions); Harrison (4 actions); Kanawha (4 actions); Marion (1 action); Monongalia (1 action); Pleasants (1 action); and Ritchie (1 action). Although actions were filed in Kanawha, Monongalia, Marion, and Pleasants Counties, all 58 Plaintiffs reside in Harrison, Doddridge, and Ritchie Counties.

4. There are approximately 49 additional cases with 98 potential Plaintiffs they expect will be filed, all based on the same operative facts and against the same Defendants as were named in *Andrews*, *Stutler* and *Shreves*. See Exhibit B.

5. The legal theories relied on by Plaintiffs are substantially identical in all of the cases.

6. A review of the claims in the filed cases evidences several common sources of the nuisances allegedly perpetrated by Defendants. Groups of Plaintiffs raise claims arising out of Defendants' activities constructing and operating wells, compressor stations pipelines, and associated activities. While not all Plaintiffs raise claims from each type of activity, significant clusters of Plaintiffs allege nuisance claims for each type of activity.

7. A review of the filed cases also evidence that the Plaintiffs allege common injuries such as water and air contamination, travel delays due to excessive traffic, light pollution, noise pollution, property damage, noxious emissions, odor, dust, erosion, and harm to livestock. Again, while not all Plaintiffs allege identical damages, significant clusters of Plaintiffs allege each type of damage.

8. Plaintiffs have identified 49 additional related cases with 98 potential Plaintiffs they expect will be filed. Defendants have not argued that these almost 100 potential Plaintiffs have claims or damages that are materially different from the claims and damages of the Plaintiffs in the cases that have been filed.

9. Judge Matish in the *Stutler* action and Judge Bedell in the *Zwiebel, et al.* action have filed responses favoring the consolidation and transfer of these cases to the Panel.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Trial Court Rule 26 provides that:

Any party, judge, or the Administrative Director of the Courts may seek a referral of actions as Mass Litigation to the Panel by filing a Motion to Refer to the Mass Litigation Panel in any circuit court in which an action is pending. The motion shall identify the nature of the actions sought to be referred, the number of plaintiffs, the number of defendants, the number of actions pending, the basis for the request, a listing of the particular actions in all the circuits for which a referral is being requested, and, if known, whether additional related actions may be filed in the future.

W. VA. TRIAL CT. R. 26.06(a)(1).

Through the creation of . . . a mass litigation panel, it was believed that this State's judicial system and those individuals seeking redress would benefit by permitting the use of innovative means of trial management concerning issues unique to mass litigation, which would in turn encourage a more expeditious resolution of these matters than that permitted by traditional means of case resolution.

State ex rel. Allman v. MacQueen, 209 W. Va. 726, 731, 551 S.E.2d 369, 374 (2001).

Trial Court Rule 26 requires that cases sought to be referred to the Mass Litigation Panel constitute "Mass Litigation." Rule 26.04(a) defines "Mass Litigation" as:

[t]wo (2) or more civil actions pending in one or more circuit courts:

(1) involving common questions of law or fact in mass accidents or single catastrophic events in which a number of people are injured; or

(2) involving common questions of law or fact in "personal injury mass torts" implicating numerous claimants in connection with widely available or mass-marketed products and their manufacture, design, use, implantation, ingestion, or exposure; or

(3) involving common questions of law or fact in "property damage mass torts" implicating numerous claimants in connection with claims for replacement or repair of allegedly defective products, including those in which claimants seek compensation for the failure of the product to perform as intended with resulting damage to the product itself or other property, with or without personal injury overtones; or

(4) involving common questions of law or fact in "economic loss" cases implicating numerous claimants asserting defect claims similar to those in property damage circumstances which are in the nature of consumer fraud or warranty actions on a grand scale including allegations of the existence of a defect without actual product failure or injury; or

(5) involving common questions of law or fact regarding harm or injury allegedly caused to numerous claimants by multiple defendants as a result of alleged nuisances or similar property damage causes of action.

W. VA. TRIAL CT. R. 26.04(a).

1. As the presence of two or more pending civil actions is sufficient to satisfy the numerosity requirement of Rule 26.04(a), the presence of 17 pending civil actions involving 59

plaintiffs pending before 8 different circuit judges in 7 different circuit courts here supports referral of these actions to the Panel. The existence of 49 additional related cases with 98 potential Plaintiffs expected to be filed further supports referral to the Panel.

2. Because the “common questions of law or fact” requirement in mass litigation is almost identical to the “commonality” requirement in Rule 23(a)(2) - “questions of law or fact common to the class” - the test for commonality under Rule 23(a)(2) is instructive in the mass litigation context:

“A common nucleus of operative fact [or law] is usually enough to satisfy the commonality requirement.” *Rosario v. Livaditis*, 963 F.2d 1013, 1017–18 (7th Cir.1992). “The threshold of ‘commonality’ is not high,” and “requires only that resolution of the common questions affect all or a substantial number of the class members.” *Jenkins v. Raymark Industries, Inc.*, 782 F.2d 468, 472 (5th Cir.1986).

In re West Virginia Rezulin Litigation, 214 W.Va. at 67, 585 S.E.2d at 67.

3. The Panel FINDS that the pending and anticipated cases present common issues of law or fact including the following:

- a. Whether Defendants’ drilling activities identified above substantially and unreasonably interfere with the Plaintiff’s use and enjoyment of their land sufficient to constitute a private nuisance.
- b. The rights of the Defendants to conduct the drilling operations identified above on properties adjacent or nearby to the property owned by Plaintiffs.
- c. Whether the damages alleged by the Plaintiffs are the proximate cause of Defendants’ activities.
- d. The measure of damages for the damages alleged by the Plaintiffs.

4. Referral to the Panel will allow the use of Mass Litigation efficiencies such as common form complaints, uniform discovery, and uniformly applicable rulings on discovery.

5. Referral to the Panel will also permit the development of a uniform body of law regarding the duties owed to the Plaintiffs and others and permit others similarly situated to the Plaintiffs and the Defendants to have a clear understanding of their respective rights.

6. Referral to the Panel will also permit the parties, at an appropriate time, to mediate these cases as a whole before the Panel's Resolution Judges.

7. Referral to the Panel would be consistent with prior consolidation of property damage claims including the Flood Litigation and the Coal Slurry Litigation.

8. While the *Andrews* action has been set for trial, the parties acknowledge that the case is not ready for trial as significant discovery remains to be completed.

9. The Defendants have not identified any specific prejudice from consolidation of these cases.

10. The Panel FINDS that, based on its experiences with other similar cases, the Panel will be able to implement efficiency saving devices without limiting the ability of the Parties to litigate non-common individual issues.

11. The Panel places great weight on the recommendations of Judge Matish and Judge Bedell that these matters are appropriate for resolution by the Mass Litigation Panel, as they are the affected judges who have been actively supervising the litigation of these cases.


RECOMMENDATION

Based on the foregoing and pursuant to Trial Court Rule 26, the Panel RECOMMENDS the Chief Justice refer these actions to the Mass Litigation Panel. Pursuant to Trial Court Rule 26.06(c)(2), the Panel will submit its "Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation of the Mass Litigation Panel" to Chief Justice Robin Jean Davis.

The Panel **ORDERS** the “Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation of the Mass Litigation Panel” **FILED** in the Circuit Courts of Harrison, Doddridge and Ritchie County, West Virginia, and made part of the record. The Clerk of the Circuit Court of Harrison County, West Virginia, is **ORDERED** to provide a certified copy of this Order to The Honorable James A. Matish, Judge of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit; The Honorable Timothy L. Sweeney, Judge of the Third Judicial Circuit; The Honorable Thomas A. Bedell, Judge of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, and any other circuit court judge listed on the attached list of cases marked as Exhibit A; the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia; and the Mass Litigation Manager.

The Clerk of the Circuit Court of Harrison County, West Virginia is further **ORDERED** to provide a certified copy of the “Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation of the Mass Litigation Panel” to the Circuit Clerks of Doddridge and Ritchie Counties. The Circuit Clerks of Doddridge, Harrison, and Ritchie Counties shall record this Order in each of the cases identified in the attached Exhibit A that are pending in their county and provide copies of the same to all parties of record or their counsel.




