

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

SUPREME COURT OF APPEALS OF WEST VIRGINIA

RE: RECALL OF THE HONORABLE A. ANDREW MACQUEEN, III TO ACTIVE SERVICE TO PRESIDE IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF KANAWHA COUNTY, THIRTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, IN ALL ASBESTOS PROCEEDINGS TRANSFERRED TO THE CIRCUIT COURT OF KANAWHA COUNTY REFERRED BY THE MASS LITIGATION PANEL

WHEREAS, By Administrative Order entered by the Chief Justice on December 20, 2000, the Asbestos cases referred to the Mass Litigation Panel, were transferred to the Circuit Court of Kanawha County with the Honorable A. Andrew MacQueen, III presiding; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable A. Andrew MacQueen, III has since retired, effective December 31, 2000, was approved for senior status on January 25, 2001, and then reappointed to the Mass Litigation Panel, under senior status, effective January 29, 2001;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, That the Honorable A. Andrew MacQueen, III, Senior Status Judge, be, and he hereby is, recalled for temporary assignment to the Circuit Court of Kanawha County, in the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit, under the provisions of Article VIII, Sections 3 and 8, of the Constitution of West Virginia, and W.Va. Code, 51-9-10, for the purpose of presiding as a member of the Mass Litigation Panel, in said matters; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That a copy of this ORDER be transmitted to the Mass Litigation Panel and to the Clerk of the Circuit of Kanawha County to provide copies of the same to all parties of record or their counsel.
