### **Chief Justice to attend Wayne Drug Court, Mountwest announcement**

HUNTINGTON, W.Va. – Supreme Court Chief Justice Menis Ketchum will attend an announcement of an agreement between Mountwest Community & Technical College and the Wayne County Adult Drug Court.

The event will be at 5:30 p.m. Friday, April 27, at the Cooking and Culinary School off Fourth Avenue across from Pullman Plaza in Huntington; a free dinner prepared by Mountwest students will be served.

Officials from the college and the drug court will announce that the college, located in Huntington, will provide interviewing and resume skills training to Wayne County Adult Drug Court participants.

The drug court opened February 6, 2012, and so far has six participants under the supervision of Twenty-Fourth Judicial Circuit (Wayne County) Judge Darrell Pratt.
