Kanawha County Magistrates' investiture scheduled

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – All Kanawha County Magistrates will be sworn into office for their new four-year terms in a ceremony at 1 p.m. on Friday, December 21, in the courtroom of Chief Circuit Judge Louis H. “Duke” Bloom on the fifth floor of the Kanawha County Judicial Building, 111 Court St., Charleston.

The county’s ten magistrates were elected on November 6. Their new terms begin January 1, 2013. Judge Bloom will deliver the oath of office.

The magistrates are incumbent Democrats Kim Aaron, Tim Halloran, Ward Harshbarger, Pete Lopez, Jack Pauley, Joe Shelton, Traci Carper-Strickland, and Julie Yeager. They will be joined by two newly elected magistrates: Democrat Brent Hall and Republican Michael Sisson.

Incumbent Paris Workman lost in general election. Incumbent Kristen Vieweg did not seek election.
