### **National motorcycle relay to stop in Charleston**

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – The All Rise America! National Motorcycle Relay for Recovery will stop in Charleston on Thursday, May 17. A “Passing of the Gavel” ceremony is scheduled to begin at 2 p.m. at the Historic Kanawha County Courthouse Park, 405 Virginia Street East.

The cross-country motorcycle relay is sponsored by the National Association of Drug Court Professionals in honor of National Drug Court Awareness Month, which is May.

Thirteenth Judicial Circuit (Kanawha County) Judge Jennifer Bailey, who oversees the Kanawha County Adult Drug Court, will speak and introduce Governor Earl Ray Tomblin. Mike Lacy, Director of the Division of Probation Services in the Supreme Court Administrative Office, will speak and introduce representatives of several drug courts in West Virginia.

Several drug court graduates have been invited to attend and they may speak. The event is open to the public and the press.
