### **Charleston trial to be subject of TruTV episodes**

For immediate release Wednesday, November 14, 2012

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – A Charleston man’s trial on charges that he beat a woman on the side of Interstate 77, which led to the death of her 11-year-old son when the boy ran into traffic seeking help, will be broadcast nationally beginning this week.

The trial of Ethan Chic-Colbert will be televised on “In Session,” a show on the TruTV cable channel. Both the trial and the sentencing before Thirteenth Judicial Circuit (Kanawha County) Chief Judge Louis H. “Duke” Bloom will be broadcast.

It will air from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Thursday, Nov. 15; Friday, Nov. 16; Monday, Nov. 19; Tuesday, Nov. 20; and Wednesday, Nov. 21. The show does not air on weekends.

Colbert, 22, was sentenced Aug. 15 to spend between six and 30 years in prison. He was convicted in July of domestic battery, child neglect resulting in death, and three counts of gross child neglect creating a serious risk of bodily harm or death.
