Hearing scheduled in State ex. rel. D.L. and K.P. v. Stephanie Bond, et al.

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – Ninth Judicial Circuit Judge Omar Aboulhosen has scheduled a hearing in State ex. rel. D.L. and K.P. v. Stephanie Bond, et al., Case No. 12-MISC-312, involving conditions at the West Virginia Industrial Home for Youth in Salem.

The hearing will be at 8:30 a.m. Wednesday, July 10, in the visiting judge's courtroom on the fifth floor in the Kanawha County Judicial Building, 111 Court St., Charleston.

The lawsuit originally was filed in the Supreme Court on April 24, 2012. The Supreme Court appointed Judge Aboulhosen to take evidence and assigned the case to Kanawha Circuit Court for that purpose.
