Putnam County program to be named after Judge Spaulding

WINFIELD, W.Va. – There will be a ceremony at 1 p.m. Thursday, July 18, at the Putnam County Youth Reporting Center, 3266 Winfield Road, Winfield, to open and name the O.C. Spaulding Training Center. Judge Spaulding is expected to attend.

The training program, which will be housed within the youth day report center, will provide Monday-Friday education for students who have been expelled from their own schools. To receive services at the training center, the students must be adjudicated delinquent and ordered there by a judge.

Through a memorandum of understanding between the Putnam County Board of Education and the state Division of Juvenile Services, the school board will provide teachers and meals. DJS will provide space, computers, security, and group therapy for substance abuse, life skills, communication skills, and anger management.
