Access to Justice Commission discusses recommendations

For immediate release Tuesday, October 29, 2013

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – The West Virginia Access to Justice Commission held its bimonthly meeting in October in Charleston and discussed items on its list of recommendations to the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia.

The Commission delivered the recommendations and a report to the Court this summer. The recommendations were based on the report.

The Commission was established by Administrative Order on January 29, 2009. West Virginia is one of many states that have established such commissions.

“Ignoring the inability of West Virginians to have meaningful access to the civil justice system will not make the problem go away,” said Chief Justice Brent D. Benjamin. “Ignoring the problem only compounds it.”
