Justice Loughry to speak to Civil Air Patrol Cadets

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – West Virginia Supreme Court Justice Allen H. Loughry II is scheduled to talk to a group of Civil Air Patrol cadets at 6:45 p.m. Tuesday, July 8, in the Dining Hall in Building 141 of the McLaughlin Air National Guard Base (formerly 130th Airlift Wing), on Coonskin Drive in Charleston.

He will talk to the cadets – girls and boys ages 12 to 21 – about the West Virginia court system.
