**SENTENCING ORDER**

On this the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2007, came the State of West Virginia by the Prosecuting Attorney, Amy L. Mann, and came the Defendant, Sheila Grimmett, in person and by counsel, Jason Parmer, and came Judson Childs, Probation Officer and Ann Owens, Certified Court Reporter before the Honorable Robert A. Irons.

This matter is before this Court for sentencing pursuant to the Defendant making a Motion for a New Trial after being convicted of Delivering Hydrocodone and Zanax on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2007.

Whereupon the Court after hearing the statements of the respective parties, did further inquire of the Defendant and her counsel if they knew of any reason why sentencing should not be imposed and pronounced and there being none the Court proceeded.

Whereupon the Court afforded Counsel for the Defendant an opportunity to speak on behalf of the Defendant and the Court addressed the Defendant personally and afforded her an opportunity to make a statement on her behalf and to present any information in mitigation of punishment. At this time counsel for the defense requested that the Defendant be placed on probation. The Court further afforded the attorney for the State an opportunity to make a statement to the Court on behalf of the State with respect to sentencing.

And the Court after examining the report of Judson M. Childs, Probation Officer, and having maturely considered the statements of all parties, and after the responses heretofore made by counsel **DENIES** Defendant's motion to be placed on probation.

It is therefore the **ORDER** of this Court that the Defendant, Sheila Grimmett, be sentenced to the penitentiary of this State for an period of (1) one to (5) five years, and one (1) to three (3) years, to be served concurrent.


Therefore the Court then **GRANTED** a stay of sentence pending appeal. The Defendant is to remain on bond.


Whereas the Court advised the Defendant of her right to appeal said sentence.
