ORDER

On the 3rd day of October, 2008, came the defendant in person, and by counsel, John Laishley, and also came the State of West Virginia by Christopher D. Chiles, Prosecuting Attorney, Cabell County, for sentencing upon Indictment No. 07-F-141. Whereupon, the Court inquired if there was any lawful reason why sentence should not be imposed, and no lawful reason being shown, the Court proceeded with disposition of the above-styled case.

It is therefore ORDERED that the defendant is hereby remanded to the custody of the Commissioner of Corrections for assignment to a Penitentiary of this State, there to be confined for a period of Thirty Six (36) years with credit for time served in jail. The defendant does not receive any credit for time served while on home confinement.

In addition the defendant is hereby assessed in the amount of Seventy Five Dollars, (\$75.00) to be paid to the Clerk of the Circuit Court, pursuant to 62-5-10 of the West Virginia Code for the Crime Victims Compensation Fund.

There appearing to the Court that there is no further need for bond in this matter, the Clerk of the Circuit Court shall deduct any fines and court costs, as directed by the Court, and return the remainder of said bond to the surety.


There being nothing further to be done in this cause, this matter is hereby ORDERED to be stricken from the trial docket of this Court.
