ORDER

The defendant, TIMOTHY C. EDMONDS, who stands convicted of the felony offense of Sexual Abuse by a Parent, Guardian, Custodian or Person in Position of Trust as contained in Count Five of Felony Indictment Number 08-F-597, and of the felony offense of Sexual Abuse by a Parent, Guardian, Custodian or Person in Position of Trust as contained in Count Six of Felony Indictment Number 08-F-597, and of the felony offense of Sexual Abuse by a Parent, Guardian, Custodian or Person in Position of Trust as contained in Count Seven of Felony Indictment Number 08-F-597, by a jury verdict returned on the 28th day of January, 2009, appeared in Court, in person and together with his counsel, Ronnie Sheets, and also came the State of West Virginia by K. Michele Drummond, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney in and for Kanawha County.

THEREUPON, it was demanded of the said TIMOTHY C. EDMONDS if anything he had or knew to say why the Court should not now proceed to pronounce the sentence of the law against him, and no valid reason being offered or alleged in delay of judgment, it is considered by the Court as follows:

08-F-597 COUNT FIVE: That the defendant, TIMOTHY C. EDMONDS, be confined in the penitentiary of this State for an indeterminate term of not less than

ten (10) years nor more than twenty (20) years, with credit for time spent in jail while awaiting trial and conviction, which credit for time so spent is eighty-eight (88) days as of April 16, 2009.

08-F-597 COUNT SIX: That the defendant, TIMOTHY C. EDMONDS, be confined in the penitentiary of this State for an indeterminate term of not less than ten (10) years nor more than twenty (20) years, said sentence to run concurrent with the sentence imposed this date in 08-F-597 Count Five.

08-F-597 COUNT SEVEN: That the defendant, TIMOTHY C. EDMONDS, be confined in the penitentiary of this State for an indeterminate term of not less than ten (10) years nor more than twenty (20) years, said sentence to run concurrent with the sentences imposed this date in 08-F-597 Count Five and Count Six.

It is further ORDERED that the proper officer do, as soon as practicable, remove and safely convey the said TIMOTHY C. EDMONDS to the penitentiary of this State, to be kept and imprisoned and maintained in the manner prescribed according to law.

WHEREUPON, the prisoner was remanded to the custody of the Department of Corrections for execution of sentence.


