On a former day, to-wit, August 22, 2014, came the Judicial Hearing Board, by Honorable Lawrance S. Miller, Jr., its chairperson, pursuant to Rule 4.8 of the Rules of Judicial Disciplinary Procedure, and presented to the Court its *Order* containing findings of fact, conclusions of law, stipulations, and its recommended disposition in the above-captioned proceeding.

Thereafter, on August 27, 2014, the Judicial Investigation Commission, by counsel Rachael L. Fletcher Cipoletti, Special Judicial Disciplinary Counsel, presented its written statement of no objection to the recommended discipline.

On this day, September 22, 2014, the respondent, Judge Jaymie Godwin Wilfong, by her counsel David A. Sims, presented her written objection to the recommended discipline.

It is hereby ordered, pursuant to Rule 4.11 of the Rules of Judicial Disciplinary Procedure that this matter be set for hearing. The Court, on its own motion, further determines that the matter should be expedited. This matter is set for hearing under Rule 19 of the Rules of Appellate Procedure at its courtroom in the City of Charleston, County of Kanawha, at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 21, 2014. The Clerk will, at a later date, furnish the parties with a Notice of Argument pursuant to Rule 19(b), which will contain additional information regarding the time for argument.

An expedited briefing schedule is hereby established. The petitioner, Judicial Investigation Commission, is directed to file an original and ten copies of a brief on or before October 3, 2014. The respondent, Judge Jaymie Godwin Wilfong, is directed to file a like number of a respondent's brief on or before October 14, 2014.

Service of an attested copy of this order upon the parties shall constitute sufficient notice of the contents herein.
